Volunteer Role

➤ Fundraiser

All the activities and services provided by the Feelgood Factory in the local community depend on funding being found to finance the work. As a result, fundraisers play a vital role in the provision of vital help for local people.

All sorts of people can be fundraisers because there is a lot of work to be done. Being a fundraising volunteer could involve running a stall at an event, speaking on behalf of the Feelgood Factory to potential supporters, attending cheque presentations or putting up posters. You would have the opportunity to organise events and engage the community in supporting us.

Responsibilities:

Based on your personal interests and skills, your responsibilities could include any of the following:

- Support local fundraising and awareness events
- Manning a stall at an event
- Putting up posters or handing out flyers
- Helping out at a supermarket bag-packing event
- Attending cheque presentations
- Approaching individuals, schools, universities, local authorities, shops and commercial organisations for sponsorship and donations
- Work with the management team to write grant applications
- Assist with operating our donor care programme.
- Design/write fundraising communications.
- Identify ways we can improve our fundraising.

- To work within a community setting
- To ensure that donors and the public receive a quality service
- To work well with the public

- To ensure that all relevant training/induction is attended
- To adhere to Netherton Feelgood Factory policy and procedure
- To promote the work of Netherton Feelgood Factory
- To ensure that all data is collected in line with GDPR and Netherton Feelgood Factory policy
- Regular reporting to the relevant Manager/Staff Member
